

Debt Collector Call Log

Before engaging in any conversation politely ask for and write down all of the information indicated below, they are required to supply it to you. Do not engage them in any conversation until you have obtained this information. If they are calling you at work and you are not allowed to receive personal phone calls, after collecting the information from the caller inform them that you are not allowed to receive calls at work and if you continue to call I can lose my job, so I am noting in my log that I have informed you of this and if you call back I will pursue my rights under the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act, after which politely end the call. Per the Federal Trade Commission, under the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act, debt collectors may contact you only between 8 a.m. and 9 p.m.; they may not contact you at work if they know your employer disapproves; they may not harass, oppress, or abuse you; they may not lie when collecting debts, such as falsely implying that you have committed a crime; they must identify themselves to you on the phone.
